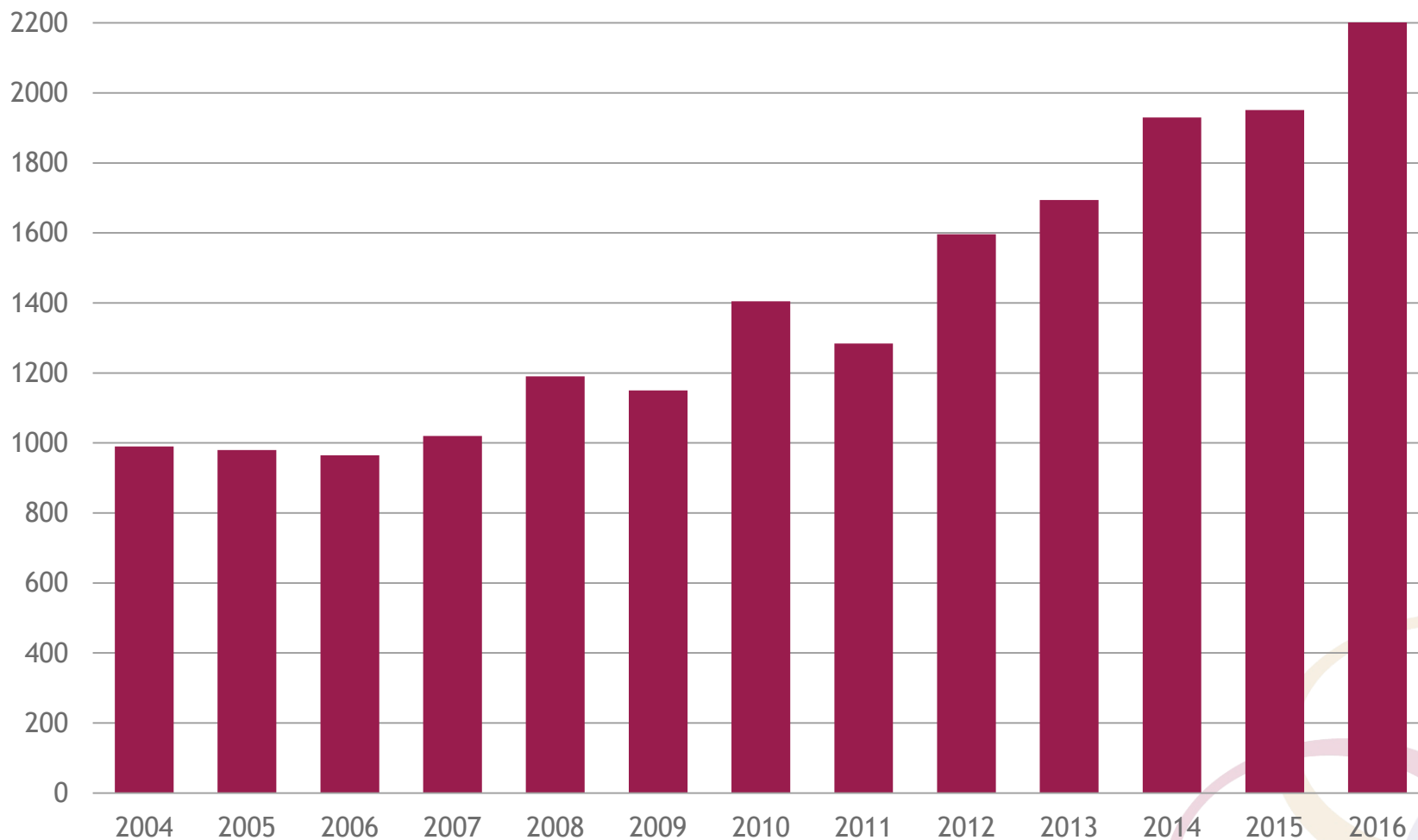

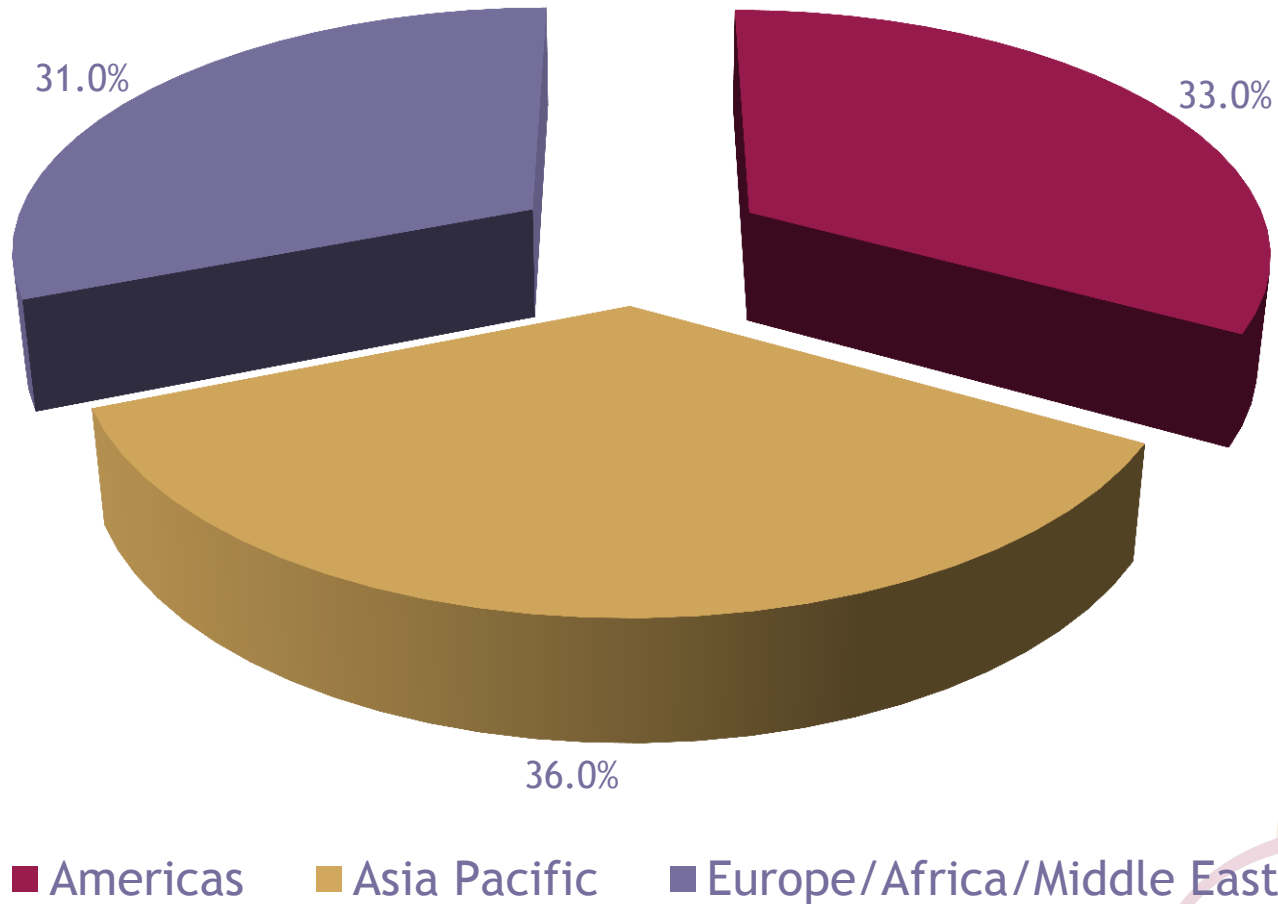

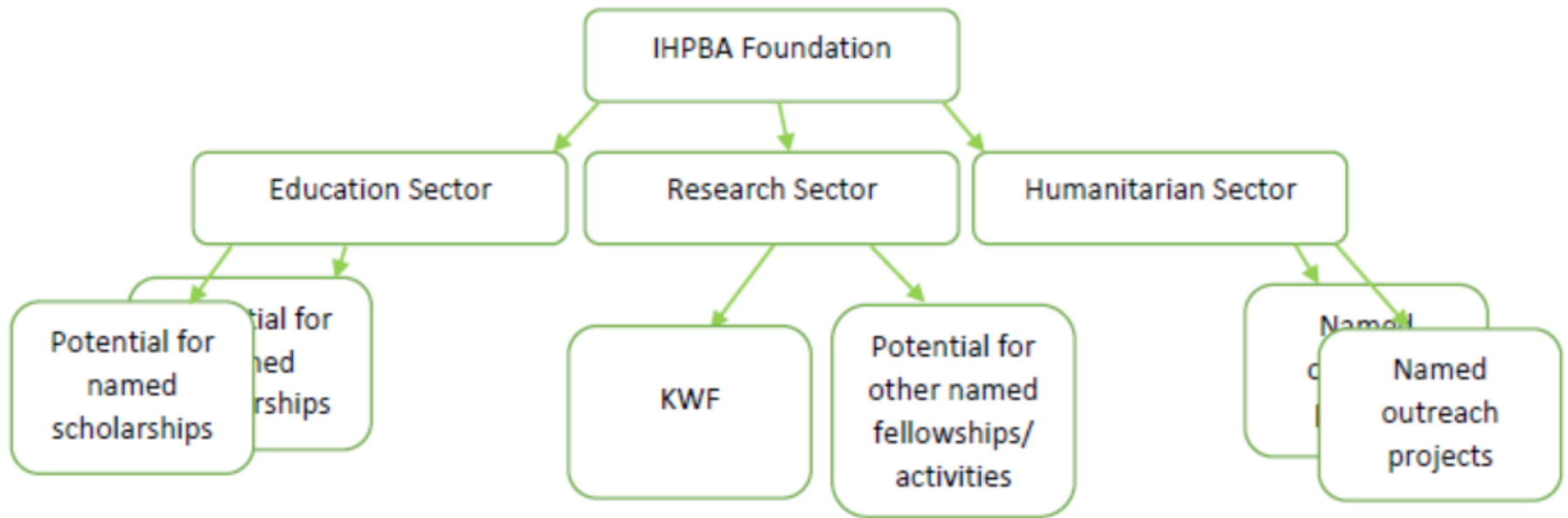

2010 - 2016



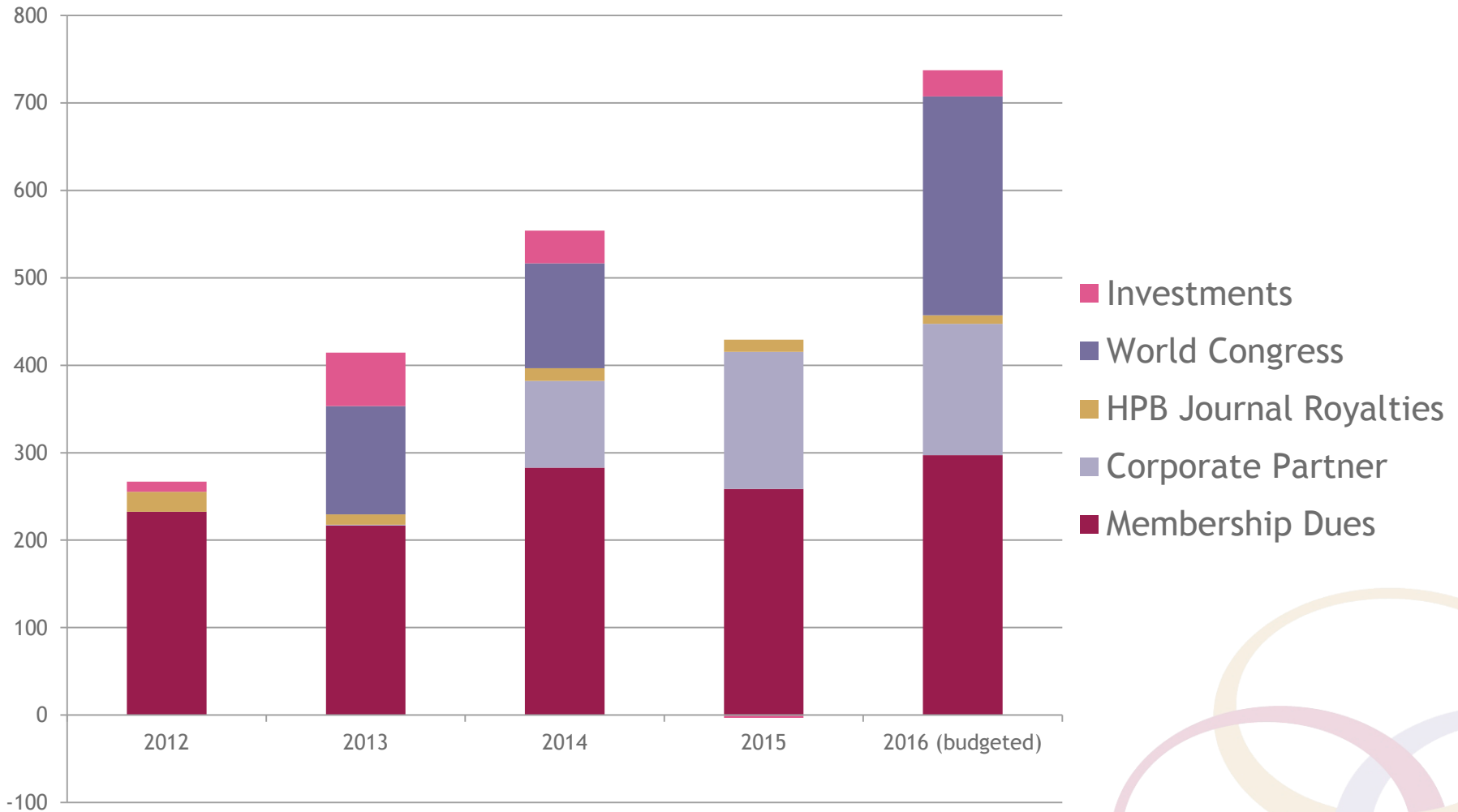

Total Income (USD Thousands)

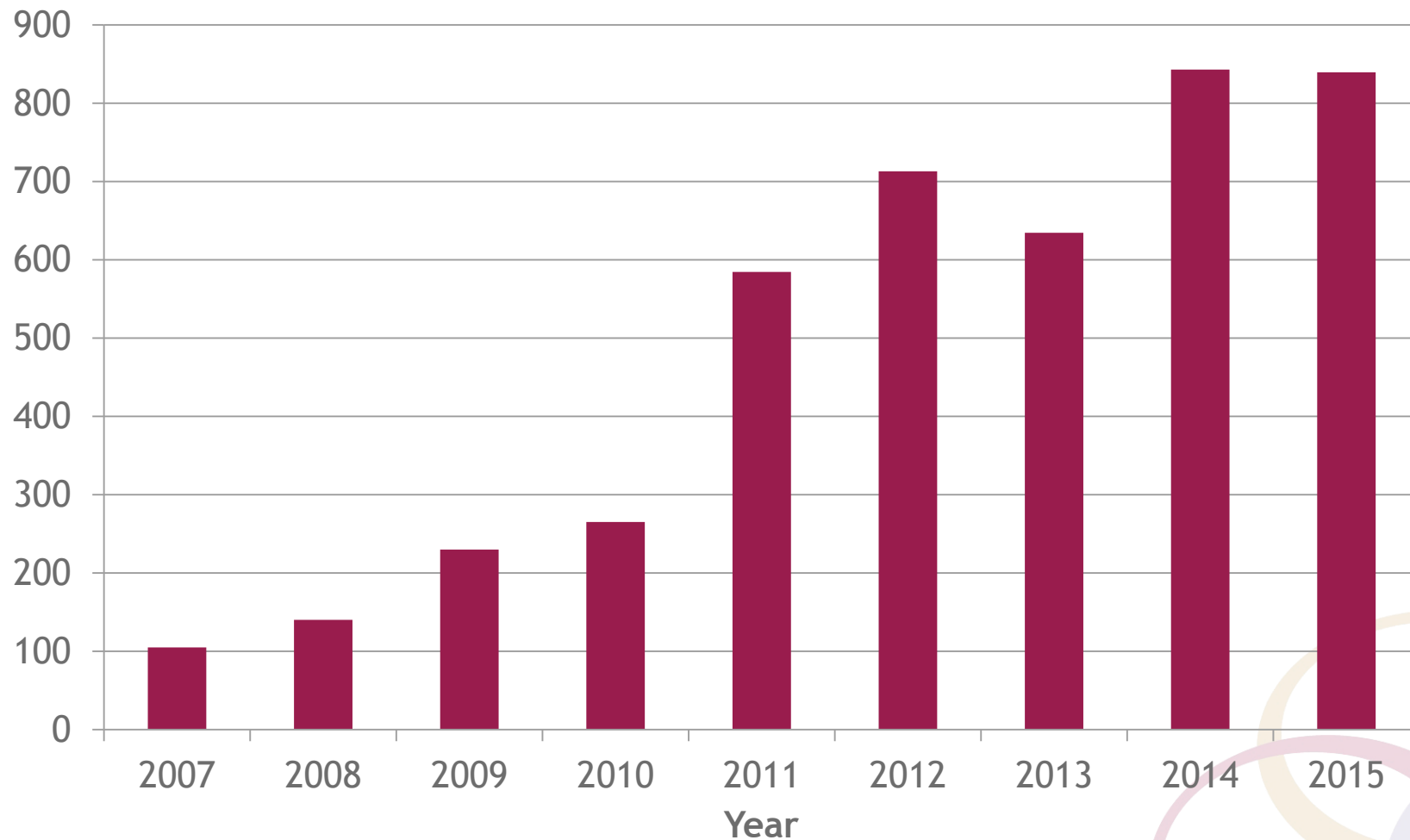


IHPBA Net Asset Trend

Net Assets (USD Thousands)

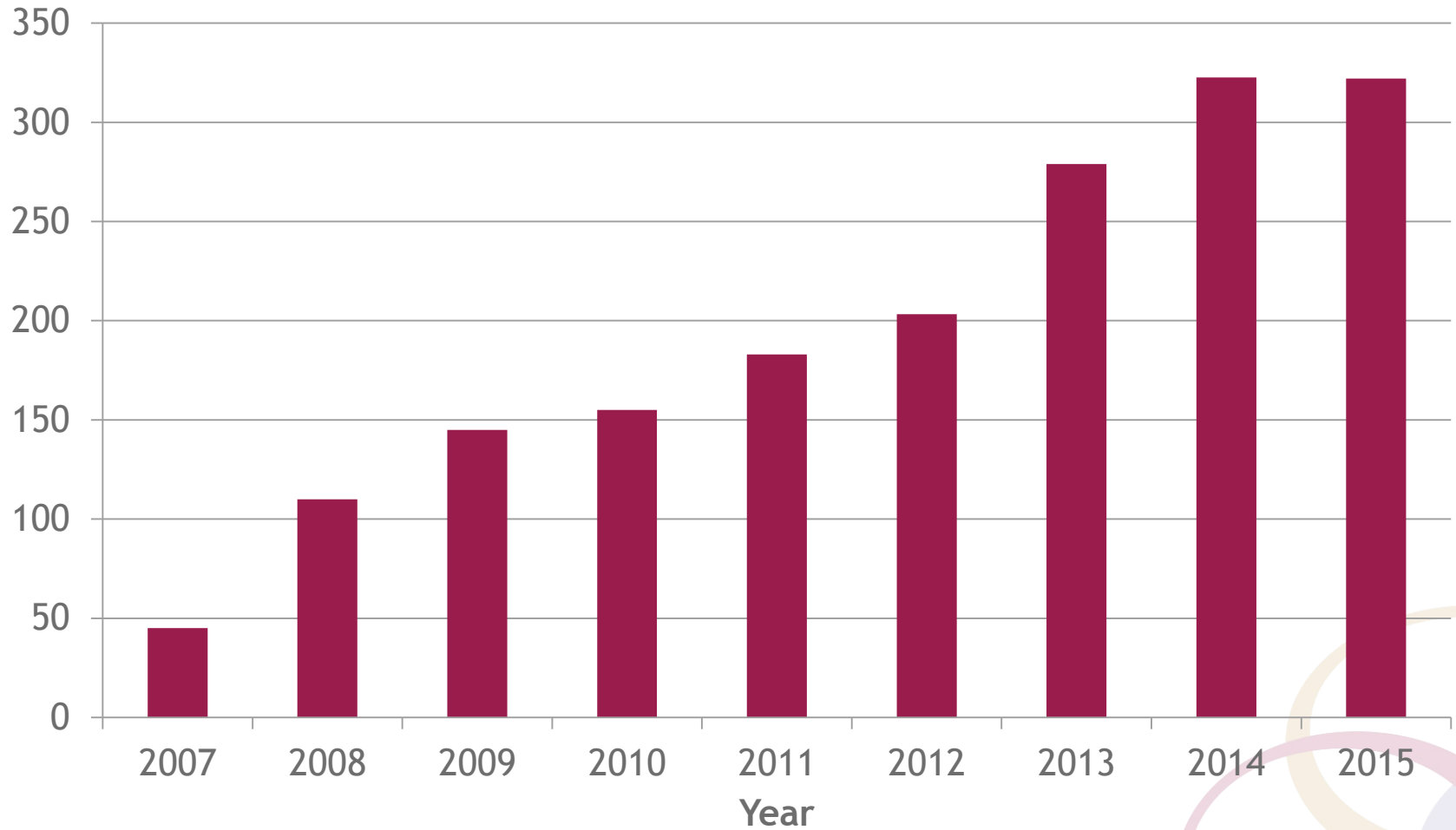


KWF Net Asset Trend
