NARRATIVE REPORT OF IHPBA OUTREACH TO NEPAL, Oct 29 - Nov 4, 2023

The fifth outreach visit of the IHPBA to Nepal in 2013, took place from Oct 29 to Nov 4.

The team initially consisted of eight international participants, unfortunately however, two participants had to cancel (including the only gastroenterologist in the team).

Hence, six surgeons, all members of the IHBA, joined the team coming from Japan, Singapore, India, UK and the Netherlands. The program was set up in close collaboration with our local partners of the Nepalese IHPBA chapter in Kathmandu.

We visited four hospitals in Pokhara, Tansen, Nepalgunj and Kathmandu, respectively, in which we organized meetings for the local and regional surgeons.

With the IHPBA secretariat, we designed 'IHPBA Certificates of Appreciation' that we handed out to our hosts at the conslusion of our meetings.


