## **Gallbladder Cancer**

The International Study Group on Gall Bladder Cancer was formed in Jan 2017 during the IHPBA meeting in Bangalore. Members of the steering group were present. The aim is to have a truly international group, which will include surgeons, medical oncologists, epidemiologists and pathologists who are focused on gall bladder cancer. A protocol was generated for the registry study along with consent forms and patient information leaflet to be submitted to the various ethics committees. Inputs from a patient support group (The Cholangiocarcinoma Foundation) were taken while developing these. The IHPBA Foundation provided further funding in 2020 to cover the following:

- Data Manager for one year (not happened due to covid pandemic over 2 yrs!)
- Admin support
- Meeting costs
- Medscinet monthly maintenance July 2021 July 2022 (12 months)
- Medscinet cost for merger of databases (Dutch, Korea/Chile): this has not yet happened

To date, IRB submissions have been approved in 19 centres and 614patients have been entered on the registry.
